

Water, water...

Scene 1

Scenary:

- Dim light
- The river – made of blue plastic or blue fabric.
- Dirty plastic and garbage (collected on an environmentalist action at school or around it) scattered around the river
- Dry and brownish landscape with a dead tree near the river
- Mechanism made in a way that labels will jump from the water

Action:

- Five people get into stage
- Each of them carries a metal cup
- Their hair is dirty and tangled
- Their clothes are dirty and grey
- Each participant has the flag of a different country on their arm (Portugal, Italy, Romania, Poland and Turkey)
- As they get into stage, they gaze at the audience and the scenery
- Next they wander around the river and try to collect water with their cups, unsuccessfully
- As they move on the labels jump from the river (Plastic! Metal! Oil! Poison! Don't drink!

IT TAKES 1 MIN 45 SEG.

– Student 1

– FIRST TO GET IN AND FRIST TO GET OUT (LEAVES AT THE SOUND OF FOOTSTEPS)

- They look at each other and start talking:
 - Student 1 - Portugal – Hello! Excuse me! Are you Turkish? What are you doing in Portugal?
 - Student 2 - Turkey – I came here because in my country we ran out of water. Even Pamukkale is dry!
 - Student 3 - Italy – Italy is dry as well! Venice has no canals! No more gondolas!
 - Student 4 - Romania – Our Black Forest in Romania is dying!
 - Student 5 - Poland – And in Poland buffalos in Bialystock have no water to drink!
 - Student 1 - Portugal – The Portuguese National Park, Gerês, has no waterfalls anymore!
 - All together – What are we waiting for? We have to do something!
- They leave the stage talking to each other about the subject.

Scene 2

A

- A group of photographers get into stage (ITALIANS – Student 7, Student 6 and Student 8) who take pictures of the scenery.
- These pictures are coming on a videowall (turtles, birds, humans... all affected by water pollution)

– Student 6

– FIRST TO GET IN (WHEN LISTENS TO FOOTSTEPS CONTS TILL 6. AND THEN GET INTO THE STAGE)

– FIRST TO GET OUT (COUNTS 9 SHOTS AND LEAVES)

B

People carrying tablets and doing research get into stage
(POLISH – Student 9, Student 1, Student 5)

- They analyze the situation and seem to solve it through technology
- On the videowall environmentalist associations from the 5 countries involved appear
- The last logo is MOTIVATION III
- There is a plan of action associated to them

– Student 5

– FIRST TO GET IN (COUNTS TILL 4 AFTER THE LAST SHOT)

– FIRST TO GET OUT (WHEN THE NEWS SONG IS OVER)

C

- Environmentalists get into stage...
(ROMANIANS – Student 3, Student 10, Student 4)
- ... with the help of robots
(TURKISH – Student 2, Student 8, Student 7)

Environmentalists and robots clean the stage until it is empty of rubbish. Only the blue river and the tree remain.

Student 3 says: **WE ARE READY!**

- They all leave

– Student 3

– FIRST TO GET IN (COUNTS TILL 4 AFTER THE NEWS MUSIC AND GETS IN)

– FIRST TO GET OUT (WHEN THE ROBOTS SONG IS OVER)

Scene 3

Student 1 and Student 5

- STUDENTS 1 AND 5 ROTATE THE SCENARY AND GET IN
- They sing “IMAGINE” and put green leaves on the dead tree.
- All actors get on stage wearing white clothes with the ERASMUS sticker.

Student 7, Student 6, Student 8

- Three students approach the audience.
- They bring one person to whom they offered a symbolic object
- Student 7 – flowers
- Student 6 – birds
- Student 8 – butterflies

Student 9, Student 10, Student 3, Student 2, Student 4

- Five students get on stage and stand holding symbolic objects on their hands.
- Student 9 – the earth globe
- Student 10 – bonsai
- Student 3 – fish
- Student 2 – the earth globe
- Student 4 – bonsai

The audience is invited to sing along IMAGINE!
